Safeguarding Your Finances

As our world becomes increasingly digital, protecting yourself from fraud has never been more critical. Here are three forms of prevalent financial fraud and best practices to protect yourself:

Romance Scams occur when a


scammer pretends to be interested in a romantic relationship with the victim, with the goal of obtaining money



or personal information. Scammers build emotional connections with victims, only to exploit their trust for financial gain. Be cautious of individuals who quickly profess love and ask for money or financial information. Always verify the identity of someone you meet online and never send money to someone you haven't met in person. If you suspect that you may be targeted by a romance scam, end all communication with the individual and report them to the appropriate authorities.

Pig Butchering is a type of fraud in which criminals lure victims into digital relationships to build trust before

convincing them to invest in a product which is oftentimes cryptocurrency. They usually involve some type of fake claim or falsified dashboard that shows assets growing at a rapid pace, with the intent of encouraging larger investments. The fraud actors gain the trust of the victim ("fatten them up") before then taking all of their money ("butchering"). Similar to a romance scam, if you suspect that you may be targeted, it's important to end communication with the potential scammer and report the incident to Pima Federal and/or the authorities.



Elder Abuse is a serious issue which can lead to financial exploitation. Scammers often target our elderly community by taking advantage of their trust and vulnerability. Family members, caregivers, or strangers may take



advantage of an elderly person to gain access to their finances. It's important to have conversations with elderly loved ones about the signs of financial abuse. Elderly individuals should seek support from trusted sources if they suspect they're being exploited.

Protecting yourself from fraud requires vigilance, awareness, and proactive measures. By staying informed about common scams and taking steps to safeguard your personal information, you can reduce the risk of falling victim to financial fraud. It's important to regularly review your accounts for suspicious activity.
